The purpose of this EEO Public File Report (“Report”) is to comply with Section 73.2080 (c)(6) of the Federal Communication Commission’s EEO Rules.

This Report has been prepared on behalf of the Station Employment Unit that is comprised of: FM broadcast station WJXR; and is required to be placed in the public inspection file of the station and posted on our website.

The information contained in this Report covers the time period beginning October 1, 2008 to and including September 30, 2009 (the “Applicable Period”).

Each of the referral sources listed under Column 1 was contacted for the position listed in Column 3.

For the purposes of this Report, a vacancy was deemed "filled" not when the offer was extended, but when the applicant accepted the job offer. A person was deemed "interviewed" whether he or she was interviewed in person, over the telephone or by e-mail.

Appendix 3

Section 3: Supplemental (Non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken by Radio Station WJXR:

Activity: Baker County Fair (October 6, 2008)

Activity: North Florida Council On Scouting

Description: Several times during the year, the WJXR station manager conducted career days or discussed broadcasting at the North Florida Council On Scouting. The Boy Scouts also toured the studio to view radio operations.

Activity: Baker County Chamber of Commerce Events

Description: Representatives of the station promoted employment opportunities at the station at several BCCC events during the year.
